

Heart diseases in Dogs

The development of veterinary medicine and life extension of pets have caused, that dogs are increasingly diagnosed and treated with heart diseases. In most cases these diseases have a completely different causes than in human, and heart failure in dogs results mainly from myocardial valvular degeneration (so-called endocardial disease), that occurs in dogs of smaller breeds from dilated cardiomyopathy, which is more common in large and giant breeds.

Why we need to act?

Despite the huge advances in science, the availability of medicines for the treatment of heart disease in dogs is limited. Especially that it is not known exactly what is the cause of endocardosis diagnosed in almost 70% of cases of heart disease. It is also not known how to treat it. 

1 L-CARNITINE

"Energy production"

2 Taurine

- regulates the level of calcium ions and the osmotic potential

3 Coenzyme Q10

"Antioxidant"
