



## How Hot Spot looks like?

- + A sore wound, most often on the cheeks and upper limbs.
- + A vivid red color of the lesion.
- + Hair loss on the area of wound.
- + The unpleasant smell of the wound.
- + Itching of the inflamed skin.

## What to do?

- + Treatment of hot spot skin lesions should begin from identification of their cause and, if possible, its elimination.
- + It is also important to eliminate itching so that the dog does not irritate the lesion.
- + Disinfection of the skin using specialized product will limit the growth of bacteria and fungi.
- + The advantage of local therapy is the action at the site of ongoing inflammation.
- + If more severe lesions and infections occur, antibiotics and corticosteroids may be necessary.

## HOT SPOT SPRAY

## What is a hot spot?

**Hot spot** is one of most common types of clinical skin lesions in dogs. This is a sudden, **local, acute inflammation that has a bacterial basis.**

In majority of cases it is a superficial inflammation, although it can also invade deeper layers of the skin.

**It occurs mainly in summer, in long-haired and thick-haired dogs.** This disease has a tendency to reccure.

## Causes of hot spots and its prevention

The causes of hot spots could be very different.

**One of the main factors predisposing to this lesion is a moisture,** which accumulates in close proximity of dog skin, under a dense coat , **resulting in "skin scalding".** Other factors that lead to hot spot include:

- + Allergic reactions to bites of fleas, ticks or other insects.
- + Mechanical irritation.
- + Food allergies.
- + Atopic disease and inhalant allergens.

**The silver nanoparticles** contained in the product have **antibacterial and disinfectant properties**, and also accelerate the healing of damaged tissues.

**Tea tree oil** has antiseptic properties.

**Aloe vera oil** reduces the inflammation of the skin and accelerates the healing process.

**Panthenol** is a moisturizer which soothes irritations and accelerates the regeneration of the epidermis.

**Chamomile extract** has soothing and antiinflammatory activity, reducing itching and burning.

## Usage

- 1 Spray evenly the lesions on animal skin from a distance of 15-20 cm.
